Parking: Parking along Lee Way/Pennsylvania Avenue

ROCKFIELD PARK, Route 22

Directions: Churchville Road (MD 22) ½ mile east of MD 924 or 1 mile west of Moores Mill Road

Parking: Available at the playground from entrance at John Carroll School, baseball/softball diamonds from Route 22, Rockfield Manor from Route 22 and soccer field from Ewing Street.
