Introduction to The Live Thriller


"Paris, a winter night like many others. Wind and rain lash at your face. In the distance, you hear the rumble of Ordener street. You were just given a report form: black hair, military jacket, bizarre gait. Here he is, sitting alone on a bench. Suddenly, he gets up. Your mobile rings: "Follow him, and see what you can get."

The guy aimlessly wanders for a few minutes, before stepping into a building. This is your chance to catch him. You enter carefully. Inside, a dim light defines the shapes of an abandoned shop. A smell of alcohol and wet dog fills the room. Not a living soul here, at least not apparently."

Welcome to the first live criminal investigation. For more than 2 hours in the heart of the 18th arrondissement of Paris, hunt down the Director, a mysterious serial killer who replaces the corpses of his victims by store mannequins.








O1 THE COMPANY Experiences at the edge of reality

02 **THE UNIVERSE** Did you say Thriller?

The Mannequins Case

"A winter night, somewhere on the outskirts of Paris. Inspector Nils and his Deputy Gambale pace down the corridors of an abandoned slaughterhouse for half an hour, when they encounter a bizarre crime scene. Two store mannequins staged like rotting corpses.

Thinking of a mere hoax, they had no idea this was the first work of a psychopath, later known as the Director."

This initial situation is introduced in the Prologue, an 11-minutes short movie integrated in the beginning of the experience, and available on the website as an interactive photo-novel (links can be found on page 13).

The players show up years after, while the investigation is at a standstill and victims follow on after one another. They will live the day everything went mad.

The influence of American cinema

The Live Thriller universe is in line with the ones of American thrillers from the '90s (Seven, The Silence of the Lambs, The Bone Collector) and more recently with video games like Heavy Rain or Condemned. It uses the same codes: a dark urban atmosphere, abandoned places, a mysterious serial killer, tortured minds and a deadlocked investigation.

Real-life scenery

The experience runs through several places for approximately 250 m^2 (2700 sq. ft.) in Paris. For a better immersion into reality, locations are not disclosed to the public. There is no window display, no The Live Thriller sign in the streets.

We have paid the greatest attention to make the scenery realistic. There is no cardboard cut-out or furniture taken from a famous Swedish store. Every corner, photo or item has a soul, and sometimes, even a smell.

From the dilapidated shop to the insalubrious squat, the scenery is dark, seeping and disturbing, only enhanced by tiny steams of light.

03 THE CONTENT No sofa, no pop-corn

At the heart of the investigation

Throughout the development, we kept one motto in mind: get the players out of their comfort zone, to make it impossible to guess what is going to happen within the next 20 minutes. It is therefore no coincidence if The Live Thriller lasts for more than 2 hours, This time is necessary to offer different atmospheres and break the linearity. Moments of action are put at the most unexpected times. On the agenda: exploration of abandoned basements, crime scene analysis, brutal interrogation or street surveillance.

"Cutscenes" video sequences

Like many video games with advanced narration (Final Fantasy, Metal Gear Solid), 30 minutes of movie cutscenes are displayed at key moments of the experience. In the form of short movies, they offer a pause in the action and drive the scenario.

The soundtrack

Special emphasis was placed on sound environment. The original soundtrack, composed by Félix, was recorded with an orchestra of 30 musicians at the East Connection Studio of Budapest, one of the best in Europe.

Music and sound effects adapt to the players progression throughout the experience. Orchestral themes are sometimes replaced by pure eerie sound effects, before coming back for cutscenes and suspense parts.


And even more

04 **THE INTERACTION** One adventure, four endings

Players influence the experience

The storyline is at the heart of the adventure, leading logically the players toward one of the four possible endings. Of course, we cannot guarantee the mainstream happy one.


Every action and decision of the players and their influence on the storyline was anticipated and written in a decision tree. The Live Thriller gives them the illusion of choice in an open world, even though everything was planned and circumscribed. A group wants to take initiatives? He will get rewarded. On the contrary, a group prefers to be driven by the experience? No problem, everyone will reach an ending.

Professional actors

The adventure is driven by several professional actors, who play their part as in any theatre show or movie. They are free to adapt it to their own personality and to the players behavior. Two performances are therefore, to some extent, always different.

Meticulous script

It took us several months and dozens of versions to write both the dialogue and action scripts. Every single action made by the actors is synchronized thanks to private communication systems and hidden control rooms. Those who liked the movie The Game will find particular resonance.









Richard Nils

Inspector Richard Nils is in charge of the case. As an old and bored cop, he spends his career-end nights emptying bottles of whiskey.



Paul Gambale

The young Deputy Inspector, obsessed with the Mannequins Case from the very first scene discovered in the slaughterhouse.



The Director

The psychopath suspected of 9 abductions and murders. Nobody knows anything about him, except that he pictures himself with a faceless mannequin on every scene.



A social outcast

Unintentionally, this young junkie will play a major role in the resolution of the investigation.



The past always surfaces.
